We are excited about all GOD is going to do in at EKO Camp and we'd like to invite you to join us. EKO Camp began back in 1991 with 14 youth under leadership of Eddie Cole and has grown to serving over 5,000 teenagers in the last 29 years. This camping experience will allow teenage youth to participate in various activities such as canoeing, ropes courses, field games, basketball tournaments, swimming and most importantly high-energy worship with life skill workshops. It is our objective to ensure that our environment allows for kids to just be kids and have an encounter with Jesus like never before.

On **March 6 – March 8, 2020**, EKO will host over 125 teenagers at Southwind Campground located in Ocala National Forest and we are looking forward to your youth ministry joining us. All those who work in youth ministry understand that many of our youth are facing some of the same issues we did growing up, however, the tactics of the enemy have become sneakier with time. Our ultimate goal is to introduce Christ to some and present him in another light to others. EKO Camp will give the youth that you serve an additional opportunity to worship through praise and fellowship with both believers and unbelievers, so they may encourage each other, share their testimony with those not yet committed to Christ and learn about ways to counteract the enemy.

At camp you may find that your youth go to school with many of the participants, as we serve youth from over 25 Orange County Florida high middle schools, a host of middle and high school from Seminole Country and other Central Florida communities, as well as out of state. These youth come from local churches such as River of Life Christian Center, The Life Center Church, Joshua Generation Outreach Center, Redeeming Light Center Church, Mission Road Church and Macedonia Missionary Baptist of Melbourne.

The total cost of this weekend \$250.00, but EKO works hard to keep costs down and we sponsor \$100.00 towards each camper, so the cost of attending will only be \$150.00, which includes all the above events plus transportation, lodging and food.
